Instructions for Presenters (Oral and Posters)

Each session will have a best paper award and will received the certificate of best paper award.

Oral Presentations

- 1. Use Power point.
- 2. Only one projector located in the front at the session venue will be available for presentation.
- 3. Slides should be submitted and self-edited at the Slide Preview/Speaker ready room at least 3 hours before your presentation.
- 4. There is no limit to the number of slides, but speakers are reminded to stay within the allocated time of 6-7 min depending on the number of presenters in the session with about 1 min of discussion time and you should discuss time allocation with your Chairperson.
- 5. All speakers should report to the Chairperson at the venue of the presentation 15 minutes before starting the session of your presentation.
- 6. Please adhere to the time allocation already notified to you.
- 7. Speakers are requested to remain at the session venue until the Chairperson concludes the session.

Poster Presentations

- 1. Presentation and discussion will be conducted in front of the respective posters to answer attendee questions.
- 2. Presenters are requested to put up their own posters in the specified area.
- 3. The size of the poster should be 3 ft wide and 4 ft long (height).
- 4. The format of the posters is free, but you must consider the following points.
 - A. Papers will be presented in English.
 - B. The title should be capitalized, except for scientific names must be recorded with a combination of upper / lower case italics.
 - C. The authors' names should start with your last name. Underline the name of the author who will present the poster.
 - D. Enter the unit where the work was done and e-mail of the presenting author.
 - E. The poster should contain: Introduction, Objective (s) Methodology, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, References (maximum five).
 - F. The document is recommended to be prepared in Arial format with a minimum size of 24.
 - G. Figures and tables are absolutely necessary and we strongly recommend taking care for the contrast and size.
 - H. The posters will be set with material supplied by the organizers and according to the directions given in the area.
- 5. Posters should be removed by the presenters themselves. Posters left behind after the specified time will be disposed of by the Secretariat.
